**Projects:** Over the last 12 months, we have worked on a wide range of projects. These are just some of those:

- development 'Maes Bleddyn' in Rachub for Adra. The scheme is part of the North Wales Collaboration. Consisting of 30 no. new homes for affordable rent, currently under construction.
- 3 Working together with Wirral Borough Council we successfully secured Town Deal Funding for the next 4 phases of work at Birkenhead Priory which will deliver improved visitor facilities and structural repairs to the Chapter House.
- 5 Pentre Canol, a new supported living village in the 6 centre of Denbigh was handed over in spring 2022, comprising 52 extra care apartments for Grŵp Cynefin and Denbighshire County Council.
- 7 'Altbridge' in Croxteth, Liverpool, a residential development consisting of 33 no. homes and 24. no. flats for affordable rent, was completed for Cobalt Housing in Summer 2022.
- 9 Plas Farrar, a new development of general need apartments in Bangor was handed over in April 2022. 10 Working with The Peel Group we helped them secure The 38 new homes for Adra are located on a prominent corner within the city centre close to local amenities.

- 1 Planning approval was granted for a new residential 2 Crown Buildings, a new Wellbeing Hub in Wrexham, was handed over to Wrexham County Borough Council in Nov '21 and shortlisted for the Construction Excellence Wales Net Zero Award 2022. Works included over-cladding the existing facades, remodelling and refurbishment of the building internally.
  - Completed in Summer 2022, working with the project Architects, Architecture JD, we acted as Conservation Architects on the restoration of the Grade II listed 509-515 Lord Street in Southport
  - Our long standing relationship with Lovell Partnerships again continued with sites from the Midlands up to the Scottish Borders, ranging from 40 - 700 homes either under construction or in design development.
  - Our over-55's apartments and community hub in Treberth, Newport, was completed in August 2022. Providing 45 apartments and shared social facilities for Pobl, with residents living in over 300 bungalows neighbouring the site designed by AGA.
  - Town Deal Funding for their retrofit project Sustainability Central Hub, in Wirral Waters.
