This target is currently under review and will be reduced with a view to a new achievable target prior to the 2050 deadline.

We fully recognise the responsibly we have as an architectural practice to understand and reduce our carbon impact through our operation.

We have for several years committed to monitoring our footprint and taking significant steps towards Net-Zero Carbon. Monitoring of impacts through Environmental Management Systems assessed by UKAS accredited auditors and registered as meeting requirements of ISO 14001.

Through our practice, we continually seek to promote Low Carbon Design and implement the latest environmental design innovations in our work. We are acutely aware of the concerns of our clients and the communities that may be impacted by our work, ensuring that we have the lowest possible environmental impact on all those involved.



# SCOPE 1, 2 & 3 EMISSIONS

### **EMISSIONS REPORTING**



Our emissions for Scope 1 and 2 have significantly declined and continue to contribute to make a large contribution to our overall Carbon Reductions. Our ongoing move to remote working has significantly reduced our Scope 1 and 2 contributions and we anticipate that this will continue to fall in line with our Net Zero Carbon targets.

Scope 3 emissions remain voluntary, however we have chosen to include Business Travel emissions to monitor our reductions in this area. During 2023, our Scope 3 emissions were significantly reduced though the continuous introduction of online meetings and CPDs as opposed to in person, reducing our impacts from travel.

NB: The data used to calculate our CO2e footprint is, to the best of our knowledge, accurate. If our monitoring notes a requirement to re-calibrate our statistics, we reserve the right to do so without penalty.



### **ACHIEVING NET ZERO**

We are pleased to see the continuous reduction of our carbon emissions over time, and are hopeful to reduce our carbon emissions to Zero before the UK 2050 target.

Measures to be considered in the coming years include switching to a 100% renewable energy supplier across our offices to further reduce our carbon emissions by a third.

We will also consider joining a UK based, verified Carbon Offsetting scheme, such as AFOLU projects and long term Carbon Capture, in order to achieve NetZero Carbon.

### **CARBON REDUCTION INITIATIVES**

As a practice, we have implemented a programme of carbon reduction initiatives to ensure we continue to prioritise and reduce are environmental impact.

AGA, as part of the larger architecture and construction industry, believes in a continuous effort to reduce our carbon impact. We will continue to monitor and analyse our carbon impact, informing how we work and sharing our findings to inspire further change.

## **SUMMARY OF 2024 INITIATIVES:**

















- We actively encourage the use of public transport, walking and cycling both when commuting and travelling to and from site visits.
- We have implemented a Switch It Off Scheme within the office to ensure all electrical appliances and switches are turned off when not in use or when away from the desks.
- We have a reduced paper use policy where we encourage paperless work where possible. We have a black and white printing policy and print double sided or on recycled paper as much as possible.
- We have implemented Hybrid Working in order to reduce commuting and office space needs.
- We encourage online meeting as much as possible, including inter office teams meetings and online CPDs to reduce travel.
- We hold Quarterly Sustainability Focus Groups to discuss new ideas about how we can be more environmentally conscious as a practice, including our Carbon Reduction Plan.
- We implement staff training to keep all members up to date and informed about how to implement environmental policies.
