- 2 x Crab apple, *Malus sylvestris* – Standards, 80-100cm, stakes and shelters, 303 provenance - in accordance with BS: 3998/2010.

Please use this e-mail as a subsequent addendum to the report. Trees can be sourced from Preeth Heath Forest Nurseries or Mailor Forest Nurseries – Whitchurch. Containerized stock to be used between March and October – bare root stock from October to march.
